Every winter for the past 10 years, the Reno Bike Project's "Freewheels for Kids" community outreach program has provided free bikes to kids from families with limited resources. Children's bikes, donated by community members, are repaired and tuned up by RBP volunteers. So far, over 1,000 bikes have been donated and refurbished! Those bikes are then donated to community organizations like St. Francis of Assisi Food Pantry, who distribute them to families in need. This year we were able to provide free bikes to <u>70</u> children whose families come to the pantry for food assistance. May they ride on to plenty of fun in 2020!
